



Important Dates and Reminders – August 2018



Attendance is very important for your student. Studies have shown that good attendance has a direct effect on school performance and grades. School starts at 7:30am and dismisses at 2:25pm (Wed 1:10pm). The building opens at 7:15am. It is very important that your student is at school on time. If your student has 6 or more absences or tardies, you will be required to attend a meeting with staff (including the principal) to discuss how to improve your child's attendance. Attendance is reflected in our school's State Report Card.



Now that we have completed our first full week of school, we request that you allow your child to walk to the classroom by themselves. There are many staff members in the halls to help students. This also helps the student become more independent. If you still wish to walk them to their classroom, please check into the office and get a visitor's pass. This is our district's safety procedure. Once classes have started at 7:30am, parents will need to drop their students at the office.



Just a reminder that when you leave the parent pick up line after school, you may only turn right on to Dean.



In an effort to save paper, we quite often send out messages to parents. This can be in the form of a phone call, text or email. Please make sure that you have your voicemail set up so that you can receive these messages.



There will be no school on Monday September 3rd - Labor Day Holiday.
